Definition

"Developmental adapted physical education: special education" (DAPE) means specially designed physical education instruction and services for pupils with disabilities who have a substantial delay or disorder in physical development. Developmental adapted physical education: special education instruction for pupils age three through 21 may include development of physical fitness, motor fitness, fundamental motor skills and patterns, skills in aquatics, dance, individual and group games, and sports.

The determination must be made by a multidisciplinary team and supported by information collected from multiple settings and sources.
